2. Does the shipment contain lithium batteries (e.g., Laptop, cell phones, power tools)? If yes , for baggage, ensure acceptable under Passenger Provisions and document under "Reason for Acceptance". 4. Does the shipment contain any items that are pressurized? (e.g., Aerosol cans, propane, SodaStream or Thermacell cartridges, oxygen bottles, fire extinguishers, spray paint). 5. Does the shipment contain any explosives or incendiary devices? (e.g., Fireworks, ammunition, flares, Bear Bangers, Hilti shells, detonator cord). 6. Does the shipment contain any magnetized material? (Considered magnetized if it will affect a compass from 7 ft., e.g., electronic equipment, magnetic equipment, etc.) If yes, refuse shipment – Wasaya embargo	<input type="checkbox"/>	<input type="checkbox"/>

If yes, for baggage, ensure acceptable under Passenger Provisions and document under "Reason for Acceptance". If the customer answers any of the questions as "Yes", this may indicate that there are dangerous goods in the shipment and cannot travel as baggage or general cargo. The shipment must be refused unless:

- For baggage, it is allowed under IATA Table 2.3.A "Dangerous Goods Provisions for Passengers and Crew" (Passenger Provisions); or
- For cargo, a dangerous goods acceptance agent determines that the shipment does not meet dangerous goods classification criteria.

Shipment may be acceptable if prepared in accordance with Dangerous Goods requirements and accepted by a company Dangerous Goods Acceptance Agent.

If a checklist item is marked "Yes" and it is determined to be acceptable, write the reason for acceptance in the space below:

For shipments with air waybills, if the shipment is not suspect of containing any dangerous goods, write "not restricted" on the air waybill beneath the description of the shipment.
